

Student FAQ - Pre-Admission

1. Why should I join this Program?

The Prodigy Programs are an emotional outcome to support the students during the tough time of the pandemic. You should join as

- a) These Programs will provide you with a credible platform to learn fundamentally the concepts of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics
- b) These Programs will lay Strong foundation/Prepare holistically the students for JSO, NTSE, KVPY, NEET & JEE whichever is relevant for their classes
- c) It will give you an opportunity to learn from the best teachers
- d) It will give you an exposure to compete with large number of students
- e) It will give you an opportunity to write tests at national level
- f) Since the classes will online live classes, you can join this from anywhere
- g) Looking at the extreme difficulties faced by students, the course fee has been highly subsidized (minimum 75% of course fee).

2. Is it that all Students will get sponsorship of 75% in the Prodigy Programs or is there any Criteria?

The FIITJEE Medical pledge is a social initiative of FIITJEE medical to support the student community at the time when the world is ravaged with the deadly pandemic, covid-19. Prodigy Programs are part of this initiative. The 75% Sponsorship is open to all eligible students without any restriction or condition.

3. Is the 75% sponsorship only on tuition fee?

No, the sponsorship is on the entire course fee, which includes Admission fee, Tuition fee, exam fee, and digital book fee.

4. There is a mention of additional fee waiver of 25%. Can you elaborate?

The Prodigy Programs are social initiative programs and are heavily subsidised. Notwithstanding the huge financial burden, we want maximum number of students benefiting from this initiative. In this context we seek your partnership in spreading the word so that more students get benefitted. As an acknowledgement of your contribution towards the cause, we would further append your sponsorship up to an additional 25% waiver (amounts to 100% of the second instalment).

5. How can I refer?

Once you have registered through OTP verified Mobile number, you will be redirected to the share page. You have an option to share, using Facebook/Whatsapp share option available in the website.



6. How will this additional waiver have calculated?

The program fee is already heavily subsidised and the additional waiver is only our benevolent gesture towards your contribution in spreading the message. The calculation will be based on the following parameters

- a) Number of shares made by the student
- b) Number of views of the link shared by the students
- c) Number of Registrations and Enrolments through the shared link

7. What are the eligibility Criteria?

These programs are available for students studying in class VI, VII, VIII, IX, X & XI. There are no further restriction or condition

8. Is there any admission test for these programs?

No, there is no admission test. These are special programs focused to support the students affected by the pandemic.

9. What is the objective of these programs?

The objective is to support those students who wants quality learning and are interested in competitive exams like JSO, NTSE, KVPY, NEET & JEE, but are unable to do so because of various constraints like unavailability of good institutes offering live online classes, location, and financial problems.

These problems though had existed earlier, it has become more pressing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

10. What is the duration of these programs and what will be the mode of classes?

The duration of these programs will be approximately 40 to 48 Weeks. The classes will be in online mode.

11. What will be the class timing?

The classes will generally be held in evening on weekdays. (6 to 9 hours depending on the class the student is studying. However, to support students to maximum extent, there may be some classes held on Holidays and Sundays

12. Will the online mode continue even after offline classes are allowed?

These programs are intended to benefit maximum number of students who are affected due to Covid-19 pandemic. Hence, to accommodate students from all locations online classes are only possible. However, a student who intends to join offline classes



- a) May do so by joining our offline programs through admission tests.
- b) May change from Prodigy programs to relevant offline program by appearing for a program change test and paying the difference amount of the fees.

13. Will I get study material?

You will get digital study material which is included in the course and will be made available through FIITJEE's GRASP android app, can be downloaded from Play Store.

14. Will this course help me in my school?

FIITJEE believes in fundamental teaching and conceptual understanding. This course will definitely help students in their school curriculum too. Moreover, this course will improve the thinking and analytical abilities of the students. Thus, they would be able to understand the concepts at school better.

15. When will the course commence?

The course will commence on 28th of June 2021.

16. What is the admission procedure?

Admissions to these programs will be direct admissions. Please follow the steps to enroll

- Step 1: Visit FIITJEE MEDICAL PRODIGY page and register with your mobile number. Verify it with the OTP
- Step 2: Once OTP is verified, it will redirect to the enrolment page. Fill the form and submit.
- **Step 3:** Make the payment on the payment page through UPI, CREDIT CARD, DEBIT CARD or NET BANKING.
- Step 4: Download the physical enrolment form. Fill in the details and submit/courier it to the nearest

FIITJEE centre. Attach the following documents: a) 10 Passport photo b) 4 stamp photo c)School ID form d) ID proof of Parent/Guardian
